- To begin, encourage the children to draw any picture with straight lines using a pencil. Once they finish, they can paste the matchsticks on the lines.



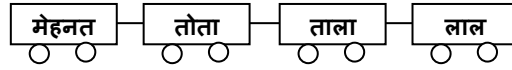

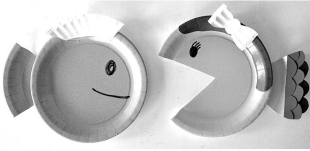

Material required:- Disposable plates, Colourful paper, Black marker, Fevicol, Acrylic Colour, Scissor.

PAPER PLATE FUN

You will need:

- A variety of paper plates.
- Paint
- Ribbon
- Chenille sticks
- Hole punch
- Scissors
- Poster board
- Plastic foam
- Thin cardboard

To make the body:

- Think about how long you want the body of your creature to be. Then choose the right number and size of plates. (perhaps, 4 for giraffe and 5 for dragon)
- You can use some colored plates and some that have prints. You can color yours with markers, crayons or paint. Just remember to let the paint dry.
- Using a hole punch, make hole in the rims of the plates. Punch only one hole in the plate that will be the head and one hole in the tail plate.
- Join the plates with ribbon. Arrange your animal's body.

To make the giraffe:

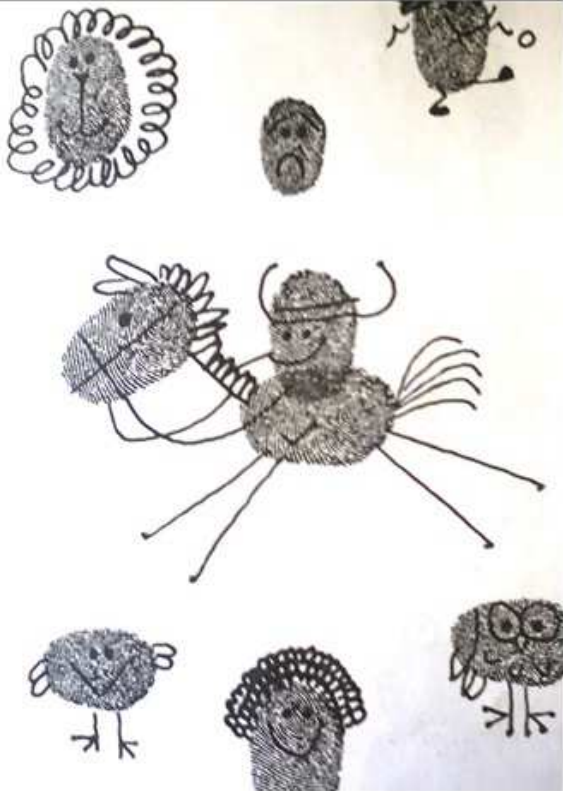
- Make the head, neck and body. Cut a tail and legs from thin cardboard. Next draw and cut out, nose, ears, and horns. Tie or tape a bundle of cut yarn and glue it to the end of the tail. Glue the tail to the body. You can take the help of the picture provided to you.
- Besides giraffe and the dragon, you can use your own ideas to make things out of paper plates. Let your imagination free and make interesting things out of paper plates.
